



## HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

We recognise our duties under the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974, the accompanying protective legislation and other applicable requirements to which we subscribe. 6. The implementation of emergency procedures – the provision of first aid and evacuation in case of fire or other significant incident.
7. The maintenance of safe and healthy working conditions, the provision and maintenance of plant, equipment and machinery, and the safe storage / use of substances.

This is also supported by our ISO 45001:2018 compliant Occupational health and safety management system.
